**PERSONNEL:** Have interviewed candidates for part-time dispatcher. Would like to hire Andrew Sefcik who has worked at the sheriff's department and lives in the village. His rate will be \$10.50 an hour. Chief would like to pass his ordinance as an emergency since the dispatch department is in need of part-timers. Would like to hire a part-time police officer. Many candidates were interviewed for the full-time position filled by Officer Pilarczyk. Some of the candidates were also interested in a part-time position. Brandon Savage passed all of the testing and is interested in working part-time. His rate will be \$12.00 an hour. Still need to continue to look for additional part-time employees.

**EQUIPMENT UPDATE:** The CAD system is now up and running. There are some glitches due to the new system. Employees are learning the system. There was a problem when the power went out at the beginning of March. The village generator was not large enough to maintain power to all parts of the building. There was no damage to the system when the power went out.

**ALARMS:** All of the alarms have been removed. A company was to be taking over for Sharon Burger but that never happened so all of the alarms were pulled and the businesses had to make other arrangements for alarm security service.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** The committee went in to executive session at 6:20 p.m. to discuss personnel matters.
